Signs & Seasons of Salvation

FALL - FORMER RAIN to the earth  
FALL - FIRST RAIN after summer  
FALL - FINAL DAYS (Rev 11:15-19)

## Day of Redemption - The Great Day of the LORD

Lev 16 (29) And this shall be a statute for ever unto you: that in the seventh month, on the tenth day of the month, ye shall afflict your souls. ... (30) For on that day shall the priest make an atonement for you, to cleanse you, that ye may be clean from all your sins before the LORD. (34) And this shall be an everlasting statute unto you, to make an atonement for the children of Israel for all their sins once a year. And he did as the LORD commanded Moses.

## The ATONEMENT - He Who was the sacrifice offers atonement for ISRAEL

Exodus 25 (1) And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying, (2) Speak unto the children of Israel, that they bring me an offering: of every man that giveth it willingly with his heart ye shall take my offering. (8) And let them make me a sanctuary; that I may dwell among them. (9) According to all that I shew thee, after the pattern of the tabernacle, and the pattern of all the instruments thereof, even so shall ye make it. Exodus 28 (1) And take thou unto thee Aaron thy brother, and his sons with him, from among the children of Israel, that he may minister unto me in the priest's office, even Aaron ... (34) ... and the priest's office shall be theirs for a perpetual statute: and thou shalt consecrate Aaron and his sons. (35) And thus shalt thou do unto Aaron, and to his sons, according to all things which I have commanded thee: seven days shall thou consecrate them. (36) And thou shalt offer every day a bullock for a sin offering for atonement: and thou shalt cleanse the altar, when thou hast made an atonement for it and thou shalt anoint it, to sanctify it. (37) Seven days thou shalt make an atonement for the altar, and sanctify it; and it shall be an altar most holy: whatsoever toucheth the altar shall be holy. (42) This shall be a continual burnt offering throughout your generations at the door of the tabernacle of the congregation before the LORD: where I will meet you, to speak there unto thee. (43) And there I will meet with the children of Israel, and the tabernacle shall be sanctified by my glory. (44) And I will sanctify the tabernacle of the congregation, and the altar: I will sanctify also both Aaron and his sons, to minister to me in the priest's office. (45) And I will dwell among the children of Israel, and will be their God. (46) And they shall know that I am the LORD their God, that brought them forth out of the land of Egypt, that I may dwell among them: **I am the LORD their God.**

## The PRIEST - He Who is both PRIEST & KING is Righteous JUDGE of ALL

Exodus 32 (1) And when the people saw that Moses delayed to come down out of the mount, the people gathered themselves together unto Aaron, and said unto him, Up, make us gods, which shall go before us; for as for this Moses, the man that brought us up out of the land of Egypt, we wot not what is become of him. (2) And Aaron said unto them, Break off the golden earrings, which are in the ears of your wives, of your sons, and of your daughters, and bring them unto me. (3) And all the people brake off the golden earrings which were in their ears, and brought them unto Aaron. (4) And he received them at their hand, and fashioned it with a graving tool, after he had made it a molten calf: and they said, These be thy gods, O Israel, which brought thee up out of the land of Egypt. (5) And when Aaron saw it, he built an altar before it; and Aaron made proclamation, and said, To morrow is a feast to the LORD. (6) And they rose up early on the morrow, and offered burnt offerings, brought peace offerings; and the people sat down to eat and to drink, and rose up to play. (15) And Moses turned, and went down from the mount, ... (19) And it came to pass, as soon as he came nigh unto the camp, that he saw the calf, and the dancing: and Moses' anger waxed hot, ... (20) And he took the calf which they had made, and burnt it in the fire, and ground it to powder, and strawed it upon the water, and made the children of Israel drink of it. (26) Then Moses stood in the gate of the camp, and said, Who is on the LORD'S side? let him come unto me. And all the sons of Levi gathered themselves together unto him. (27) And he said unto them, Thus saith the LORD God of Israel, Put every man his sword by his side, ... and slay every man ... (28) And the children of Levi did according to the word of Moses: and there fell of the people that day about three thousand men. (33) And the LORD said unto Moses, Whosoever hath sinned against me, him will I blot out of my book. (34) ... in the day when I visit I will visit their sin upon them. (36) And the LORD plagued the people, because they made the calf, which Aaron made.

Hosea 6 (1) Come, and let us return unto the LORD: for he hath torn, and he will heal us; he hath smitten, and he will bind us up. (2) After two days will he revive us: in the third day he will raise us up, and we shall live in his sight. (3) Thus shall we know, if we follow on to know the LORD: his going forth is prepared as the morning; and he shall come unto us as the rain, as the latter and former rain unto the earth. Jeremiah5 (24) Neither say they in their heart, Let us now fear the LORD our God, that giveth rain, both the former and the latter, in his season: he reserveth unto us the appointed weeks of the harvest. Haggai2 (9) The glory of this latter house shall be greater than of the former, saith the LORD of hosts: and in this place will I give peace, saith the LORD of hosts. Colossians2 (16) ... an holyday, or of the new moon, or of the sabbath days: (17) Which are a shadow of things to come; but the body is of Christ.



The Offering - HIS Atonement for their sins  
Rev 5 (5) ... the **Lion of the tribe of Juda**, the **Root of David**, hath prevailed to open the book, and to loose the seven seals thereof. (6) ... in the midst of the throne ... stood a **Lamb as it had been slain**, ... the seven Spirits of God sent forth into all the earth.

Revelation 5 (7) And he came and took the book out of the right hand of him that sat upon the throne. (8) And when he had taken the book, the four beasts and four and twenty elders fell down before the Lamb, having every one of them harps, and golden vials full of odours, which are the prayers of saints. (9) And they sung a new song, saying, Thou art worthy to take the book, and to open the seals thereof: for thou wast slain, and hast redeemed us to God by thy blood out of every kindred, and tongue, and people, and nation; (10) And hast made us unto our God kings and priests: and we shall reign on the earth. (12) Worthy is the Lamb that was slain Rev 7 (9) ... lo, a great multitude, which no man could number, of all nations, and kindreds, and people, and tongues, stood before the throne, and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, ... (10) ... saying, Salvation to our God which sitteth upon the throne, and unto the Lamb. (14) ... These are they which came out of great tribulation, and have washed their robes, and made them white in the blood of the Lamb. (15) Therefore are they before the throne of God, and serve him day and night in his temple: and he that sitteth on the throne shall dwell among them.  
**Delivered vs Destroyed**

Rev6 (1) And I saw when the Lamb opened one of the seals, and I heard, as it were the noise of thunder, ... Come and see. (2) And I saw, and behold a white horse: and he that sat on him had a bow; and a crown was given unto him: and he went forth conquering, and to conquer. (4) ... another horse that was red: and power was given to him that sat thereon to take peace from the earth, ... (5) And I beheld, and lo a black horse; and he that sat on him had a pair of balances in his hand. (8) ... a pale horse: and his name that sat on him was Death, and Hell followed with him. Rev6 (12) And I beheld when he had opened the sixth seal, and, lo, there was a great earthquake; and the sun became black as sackcloth of hair, and the moon became as blood; (13) And the stars of heaven fell unto the earth, ... (14) And the heaven departed as a scroll when it is rolled together; and every mountain and island were moved out of their places. (15) And the kings of the earth, and the great men, ... bondman, ... and every freeman, hid themselves ... (16) ... hide us from the face of him that sitteth on the throne, and from the wrath of the Lamb: (17) For the great day of his wrath is come;



The Altar - ALL Creation (spirit & physical)  
Rev 5 (13) And every creature which is in heaven, and on the earth, and under the earth, and such as are in the sea, ... saying, Blessing, and honour, and glory, and power, be unto him that sitteth on the throne, and unto the Lamb for ever and ever.

Revelation 6 (9) And when he had opened the fifth seal, I saw under the altar the souls of them that were slain for the word of God, and for the testimony which they held: (10) And they cried with a loud voice, saying, How long, O Lord, holy and true, dost thou not judge and avenge our blood on them that dwell on the earth? (11) And white robes were given unto every one of them; and it was said unto them, that they should rest yet a little season, until their fellowservants also, and their brethren, that should be killed as they were, should be fulfilled. Rev 7 (2) And I saw another angel ascending from the east, having the seal of the living God: (3) Saying, Hurt not the earth, neither the sea, nor the trees, till we have sealed the servants of our God in their foreheads. (4) And I heard the number ... and there were sealed an hundred and forty and four thousand of all the tribes of the children of Israel. Rev 14 (1) ... lo, a Lamb stood on the mount Zion, and with him an hundred forty and four thousand, having his Father's name written in their foreheads. (3) And they sung as it were a new song before the throne, ... and no man could learn that song but the 144,000, which were redeemed from the earth.  
**Delivered vs Destroyed**

Rev8(1) And when he had opened the seventh seal, there was silence in heaven ... (6) And the seven angels which had the seven trumpets prepared themselves to sound. (13) ... I beheld, and heard an angel flying through the midst of heaven, saying ... Woe, woe, woe, to the inhabitants of the earth ... Rev9 (20) And the rest of the men which were not killed by these plagues yet repented not of the works of their hands, that they should not worship devils, and idols ... (21) Neither repented they of their murders, nor of their sorceries, ... fornication, nor of their thefts. Rev11 (15) And the seventh angel sounded; and there were great voices in heaven, saying, The kingdoms of this world are become the kingdoms of our Lord, and of his Christ; and he shall reign for ever and ever. Rev14 (8) And there followed another angel, saying, Babylon is fallen, is fallen, that great city, ... (9) ... If any man worship the beast and his image, and receive his mark in his forehead, or in his hand, (10) The same shall drink of the wine of the wrath of God, which is poured out without mixture into the cup of his indignation; and he shall be tormented with fire and brimstone...in the presence of the Lamb:



The Priest - GOD'S Intermediary for people  
Rev14 (6) ... angel fly in the midst of heaven, having the everlasting gospel to preach unto them that dwell on the earth, and to every nation, and kindred, and tongue, and people. (7) ... Fear God, and give glory to him; for the hour of his judgment is come: and worship him

Revelation 14 (12) Here is the patience of the saints: here are they that keep the commandments of God, and the faith of Jesus. (13) And I heard a voice from heaven saying unto me, Write, Blessed are the dead which die in the Lord from henceforth: Yea, saith the Spirit, that they may rest from their labours; and their works do follow them. (14) And I looked, and behold a white cloud, and upon the cloud one sat like unto the Son of man, having on his head a golden crown, and in his hand a sharp sickle. (15) And another angel ... crying with a loud voice to him that sat on the cloud, Thrust in thy sickle, and reap: for the time is come for thee to reap; for the harvest of the earth is ripe. (16) And he that sat on the cloud thrust in his sickle on the earth; and the earth was reaped. Rev 15 (2) And I saw as it were a sea of glass mingled with fire: and them that had gotten the victory over the beast, and over his image, and over his mark, and over the numbering of his name, stand on the sea of glass, having the harps of God. (3) And they sing the song of Moses the servant of God, and the song of the Lamb, saying, Great and marvellous are thy works, Lord God Almighty; just and true are thy ways, thou King of saints.  
**Delivered vs Destroyed**

Rev14(17) And another angel came out of the temple which is in heaven, he also having a sharp sickle. (19) And the angel thrust in his sickle into the earth, and gathered the vine of the earth, and cast it into the great winepress of the wrath of God. (20) And the winepress was trodden without the city, and blood came out of the winepress, even unto the horse bridles, by the space of a thousand and six hundred furlongs. Rev15 (1) And I saw another sign in heaven, ... seven angels having the seven last plagues; for in them is filled up the wrath of God. Rev16 (1) And I heard a great voice out of the temple saying to the seven angels, Go your ways, and pour out the vials of the wrath of God upon the earth. (17) And the seventh angel poured out his vial into the air; and there came a great voice out of the temple of heaven, from the throne, saying, IT IS DONE. (18) ... and there was a great earthquake, such as was not since men were upon the earth ... (19) ... great Babylon came in remembrance before God, to give unto her the cup of the wine of the fierceness of his wrath. (20) And every island fled away, and the mountains were not found. (21) ... and men blasphemed God because ... of the hail.
