Scripture:	Exodus 34 (1) And the LORD said unto Moses, Hew thee two tables of stone like unto the first: and I will write upon these tables the words that were in the first tables, which thou brakest. (2) And be ready in the morning, and come up in the morning unto mount Sinai, and present thyself there to me in the top of the mount. (4) And he hewed two tables of stone like unto the first; and Moses rose up early in the morning, and went up unto mount Sinai, as the LORD had commanded him, and took in his hand the two tables of stone. (5) And the LORD descended in the cloud, and stood with him there, and proclaimed the name of the LORD. (6) And the LORD passed by before him, and proclaimed, The LORD, The LORD God, merciful and gracious, long-suffering, and abundant in goodness and truth, (7) Keeping mercy for thousands, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin, and that will by no means clear the guilty: visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children, and upon the children's children, unto the third and to the fourth generation. (8) And Moses made haste, and bowed his head toward the earth, and worshipped. (9) And he said, If now I have found grace in thy sight, O Lord, let my Lord, I pray thee, go among us: for it is a stiffnecked people; and pardon our iniquity and our sin, and take us for thine inheritance. (10) And he said, Behold, I make a covenant: before all thy people I will do marvels, such as have not been done in all the earth, nor in any nation: and all the people among which thou art shall see the work of the LORD: for it is a terrible thing that I will do with thee. (14) For thou shalt worship no other god: for the LORD, whose name is Jealous, is a jealous God: (29) And it came to pass, when Moses came down from mount Sinai with the two tables of testimony in Moses hand ... that the skin of his face shone while he talked with him. (35) And the children of Israel saw the face of Moses, that the skin of Moses face shone: Ex 35 (1) And Moses gathered all the congregation of the children of Israel together, ...

(1) Garden of Eden - Garden of GOD	Ezekiel 28 & 31
Genesis 2 (8) And the LORD God planted a garden eastward in Eden; ... (9) And out of the ground made the LORD God to grow every tree ... the tree of life also in the midst of the garden, and the tree of knowledge of good and evil. (10) And a river went out of Eden to water the garden; ... (15) And the LORD God took the man, and put him into the garden of Eden, to dress it and keep it. Genesis 3 (18) And they heard the voice of the LORD God walking in the garden in the cool of the day; and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the LORD God amongst the trees of the garden. (9) And the LORD God called unto Adam, and said unto him, Where art thou? (11) ... Hast thou eaten of the tree, ... thou shouldst not eat? (24) So he drove out the man, and he placed at the east of the garden of Eden Cherubims, and a flaming sword ... to keep the way of the tree of life.	
(2) Tabernacle of Moses - Ark of the Covenant	2 Samuel 6:1-19
Exodus 25 (1) And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying, (2) Speak unto the children of Israel, that they bring me an offering: of every man that giveth it willingly with his heart ye shall take my offering. (8) And let them make me a sanctuary; that I may dwell among them. (9) According to all that I shew thee, after the pattern of the tabernacle, ... (10) And they shall make an ark of shittim wood: ... (17) And thou shalt make a mercy seat of pure gold: ... (18) And thou shalt make two cherubims of gold, ... in the two ends of the mercy seat. (21) And thou shalt put the mercy seat above upon the ark; and in the ark thou shalt put the testimony that I shall give thee. (22) And there I will meet with thee, and I will commune with thee from above the mercy seat, from between the two cherubims Exodus 40 (33) ... So Moses finished the work. (34) Then a cloud covered the tent of the congregation, and the glory of the LORD filled the tabernacle. (38) For the cloud of the LORD was upon the tabernacle by day, and fire was on it by night, in the sight of all the house of Israel, throughout all their journeys.	
(3) Temple of Solomon - House of GOD	1 Chronicles 21 & 22
2 Chronicles 5 (1) Thus all the work that Solomon made for the house of the LORD was finished: ... (2) Then Solomon assembled the elders of Israel, ... unto Jerusalem, to bring up the ark of the covenant of the LORD out of the city of David, which is Zion. (3) Wherefore all the men of Israel assembled themselves unto the king in the feast which was in the seventh month. (7) And the priests brought in the ark of the covenant of the LORD unto his place, to the oracle of the house, into the most holy place, even under the wings of the cherubims: (13) It came even to pass, ... that then the house was filled with a cloud, ... (14)... for the glory of the LORD had filled the house of God. 1 Kings 9 (1) And it came to pass, when Solomon had finished the building of the house of the LORD, ... (2) That the LORD appeared to Solomon ... (3) And the LORD said unto him, I have hallowed this house, which thou hast built, to put my name there for ever: and mine eyes and mine heart shall be there perpetually. (2 Samuel 6 & 7)	
(4) Temple of Zerubbabel & Herod	Nehemiah & Hagga
Ezra 1 (1) ... the LORD stirred up the spirit of Cyrus king of Persia ... (2) ... The LORD God of heaven ... hath charged me to build him an house at Jerusalem, which is in Judah. Ez 3 (1) And when the seventh month was come, and the children of Israel were in the cities, the people gathered themselves together as one man to Jerusalem. (3) And they set the altar upon his bases; ... (4) They kept also the feast of tabernacles, ... (6) ... But the foundation of the temple of the LORD was not yet laid. Nehemiah 8 (2) And Ezra the priest brought the law before the congregation ... upon the first day of the seventh month. (18) Also day by day, ... he read in the book of the law of God. And they kept the feast seven days; and on the eighth day was a solemn assembly, ... Ezra 5 (2) Then rose up Zerubbabel ... and began to build the house of God which is at Jerusalem: ... Ezra 6 (14) And they builded, and finished it; according to the commandment of the God of Israel, ... (19) And the children of the captivity kept the passover ... (20) For the priests ... killed the passover for all ...	
(5) Temple of Messiah - Millennium Throne	Jeremiah 33:14-16
Zechariah 14 (1) Behold, the day of the LORD cometh, ... (3) Then shall the LORD go forth, ... (4) And his feet shall stand in that day upon the mount of Olives, ... (8)...living waters shall go out from Jerusalem; (9) And the LORD shall be king... Ezekiel 37 (27) My tabernacle also shall be with them: yea, I will be their God, and they shall be my people. Ezek 41 (1) Afterward he brought me to the temple, and measured ... the breadth of the tabernacle. Ezek 43 (2) ... the glory of the God of Israel came from the way of the east...and the earth shined with his glory. (5)...the glory of the LORD filled the house. (7)...the place of my throne...where I will dwell... Ezek 48 (35) ... and the name of the city from that day shall be, The LORD is there.	
(6) Hosea 6 (1) Come, and let us return unto the LORD: for he hath torn, and he will heal us; he hath smitten, and he will bind us up. (2) After two days will he revive us: in the third day he will raise us up, and we shall live in his sight. (3) Then shall we know, if we follow on to know the LORD: his going forth is prepared as the rain, as the latter and former rain unto the earth. Jeremiah 5 (24) Neither say they in their heart, Let us now fear the LORD our God, that giveth rain, both the former and the latter, in his season: he reserveth unto us the appointed weeks of the harvest. Hagga2 (9) The glory of this latter house shall be greater than of the former, saith the LORD of hosts: and in this place will I give peace, saith the LORD of hosts. Colossians2 (16) ... an holiday, or of the new moon, or of the sabbath days: (17) Which are a shadow of things to come; but the body is of Christ.	

Matthew 1 (20) ... Joseph, thou son of David, fear not to take unto thee Mary thy wife: for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Ghost. (23) Behold, a virgin shall be with child and shall bring forth a son, and they shall call his name Emmanuel, which being interpreted is, **God with us.** [Isaiah 7:14]

Matthew 1 (18) Now the birth of Jesus Christ was on this wise: When as his mother Mary was espoused to Joseph, before they came together, she was found with child of the Holy Ghost. (20) But while he thought on these things, behold, the angel of the Lord appeared unto him in a dream, saying, ... (21) And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call his name JESUS: for he shall save his people from their sins. (24) Then Joseph being raised from sleep did as the angel of the Lord had bidden him, and took unto him his wife. (25) And knew her not till she had brought forth her firstborn son: and he called his name JESUS.

Luke 2 (4) And Joseph also went up from Galilee, out of the city of Nazareth, into Judaea, unto the city of David, which is called Bethlehem; (because he was of the house & lineage of David;) (5) To be taxed with Mary his espoused wife, being great with child. (6) And so it was, that, while they were there, the days were accomplished that she should be delivered. (7) And she brought forth her firstborn son, and wrapped him in swaddling clothes and laid him in a manger; ... (8) And there were in the same country shepherds abiding in the field, keeping watch over their flock by night (9) And, lo, the angel of the Lord came upon them, and the glory of the Lord shined round about them:...(10)...I bring you good tidings ... (11) For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Saviour, which is Christ the Lord. (12) And this shall be a sign unto you; Ye shall find the babe wrapped in swaddling clothes, lying in a manger. (16) ... they came with haste, and found Mary, & Joseph, and the babe lying in a manger. (21) And when eight days were accomplished for the circumcising of the child, his name was called JESUS, which was so named of the angel before he was conceived in the womb. Matthew 2 (1) Now when Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judaea in the days of Herod the king, behold, there came wise men from the east to Jerusalem, (2) Saying, Where is he that is born King of the Jews? For we have seen his star in the east, and are come to worship him. (9) ... and, lo, the star, which they saw in the east, went before them, till it came and stood over where the young child was. (11) And when they were come into the house, they saw the young child with Mary his mother and fell down, and worshipped him: and when they had opened their treasures, they presented unto him gifts;

John 14 (23) Jesus answered and said unto him, If a man love me, he will keep my words: and my Father will love him, and we will come unto him, and make our abode with him... (26) But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, ...

Luke 2 (22) And when the days of her purification according to the law of Moses were accomplished, they brought him to Jerusalem, to present him to the Lord; (23) (As it is written in the law of the Lord, Every male that openeth the womb shall be called holy to the Lord;) (24) And to offer a sacrifice according to that which is said in the law of the Lord, A pair of turtledoves, or two young pigeons. (25) And behold, there was a man in Jerusalem, whose name was Simeon; and the same man was just and devout, waiting for the consolation of Israel: and the Holy Ghost was upon him. (27) And he came by the Spirit into the temple: and when the parents brought in the child Jesus, to do for him after the custom of the law, then took he him up in his arms, and blessed God, and said, (30)... mine eyes have seen thy salvation, (31) Which thou hast prepared before the face of all people; (32) A light to lighten the Gentiles, and the glory of thy people Israel. (34) ... Behold, this child is set for... a sign which shall be spoken against; Luke 3 (21) ... it came to pass, that Jesus also being baptized, and praying, the heaven was opened, (22) And the Holy Ghost descended in a bodily shape like a dove upon him, and a voice came from heaven, which said, Thou art my beloved Son; in thee I am well pleased. (23) And Jesus himself began to be about thirty years of age, ... (38) ... the son of God. Luke 4 (1) And Jesus being full of the Holy Ghost returned from Jordan, and was led by the Spirit into the wilderness, (2) Being forty days tempted of the devil. (14) And Jesus returned in the power of the Spirit into Galilee: ... (16) And he came to Nazareth, ... went into the synagogue on the sabbath day, & stood up for to read. (18) The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel ... (21) ... This day is this scripture fulfilled in your ears. [Isaiah 61:1] Jn 7 (2) Now the Jews' feast of tabernacles was at hand. (14) Now about the midst of the feast Jesus went up into the temple, and taught. (25) Then said some of them of Jerusalem, Is not this he, whom they seek to kill? (37) In the last day, that great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried, saying, If any man thirst let him come unto me, and drink. (38) He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water (39) (But this spake he of the Spirit, which they that believe on him should receive for the Holy Ghost was not yet given; because that Jesus was not yet glorified.)

Rev 11 (15) And the seventh angel sounded; and there were great voices in heaven, saying, The Kingdoms of this world are become the kingdoms of our Lord, and of his Christ; and he shall reign for ever and ever. (19) And the temple of God was opened in heaven, and there was seen...the ark of his testament:

Revelation 19 (6) And I heard as it were the voice of a great multitude, and as the voice of many waters, and as the voice of mighty thunders, saying, Alleluia: for the Lord God omnipotent reigneth. (7) Let us be glad and rejoice, and give honour to him: for the marriage of the Lamb is come, and his wife hath made herself ready. (8) And to her was granted that she should be arrayed in fine linen, clean and white: for the fine linen is the righteousness of saints. (9) And he saith unto me, Write, Blessed are they which are called unto the marriage supper of the Lamb. ... (10) ...worship God: for the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy. (11) And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and he that sat upon him was called Faithful & True, and in righteousness he doth judge & make war. (13) And he was clothed with a vesture dipped in blood: and his name is called The Word of God. (14) And the armies which were in heaven followed him upon white horses, clothed in fine linen, white & clean. (15) And out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations; and he shall rule them with a rod of iron: and he treadeth the winepress... (16) And he hath on his vesture and on his thigh a name written, **KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS.**

Zechariah 14 (9) And the LORD shall be king over all the earth: in that day shall there be one LORD, and his name one. (10) ... Jerusalem: ...shall be lifted up, and inhabited in her place, ... (11) And men shall dwell in it, and there shall be no more utter destruction; but Jerusalem shall be safely inhabited. (16) And it shall come to pass, that every one that is left of all the nations which came against Jerusalem shall even go up from year to year to worship the King, the LORD of hosts, and to keep the feast of tabernacles. (17) And it shall be, that those who will not come up of all the families of the earth unto Jerusalem to worship the King, the LORD of hosts, even upon them shall be no rain. (18) And if the family of Egypt go not up, and come not, that have no rain; there shall be the plague, wherewith the LORD will smite the heathen that come not up to keep the feast of tabernacles. (19) This shall be the punishment of Egypt, and the punishment of all nations that come not up to keep the feast of tabernacles. Revelation 21 (5) And he that sat upon the throne said, Behold, I make all things new. (6)...I am Alpha and Omega...I will give unto him that is athirst...of the water of life freely.
