SO WHAT ...

Romans 1 (18) For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who hold the truth in unrighteousness: (19) Because that which may be known of God is manifest in them: for God hath shewed it unto them. (20) For the invisible things of Him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even His eternal power and Godhead; so that they are without excuse: (21) Because that, when they knew God, they glorified Him not as God, neither were thankful; but became vain in their imaginations, and their foolish heart was darkened. Romans 5 (8) But God commendeth His love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. (9) Much more then, being now justified by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath through Him. (10) For if, when we were enemies, we were reconciled to God by the death of His Son, much more, being reconciled, we shall be saved by His life. (11) ... we also joy in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, by Whom we have now received the atonement. 1Cor 1 (30) ... Christ Jesus, Who of God is ... wisdom, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption

1 Corinthians 15 (20) But now is Christ risen from the dead, and become the firstfruits of them that slept. (21) For since by man came death, by man came also the resurrection of the dead. (22) For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ shall all be made alive. (23) But every man in his own order: Christ the Firstfruits: afterward they that are Christ's at His coming. (45) And so it is written. The first man Adam was made a living soul; the last Adam was made a quickening spirit. (46) Howbeit that was not first which is spiritual, but that which is natural; and afterward that which is spiritual. (47) The first man is of the earth, earthy: the second man is the Lord from Heaven. (48) As is the earthy, such are they also that are earthy: and as is the heavenly, such are they also that are heavenly. (49) And as we have borne the image of the earthy, we shall also bear the image of the heavenly. (50) Now this I say, brethren, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God; neither doth corruption inherit incorruption. (56) The sting of death is sin; and the strength of sin is the law. (57) But thanks be to God, which giveth us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.




Isaiah 53 (1) Who hath believed our report? and to whom is the arm of the LORD revealed? (3) He is despised and rejected of men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief: and we hid as it were our faces from Him; He was despised, and we esteemed Him not. (4) Surely He hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem Him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted.

- (5) But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon Him; and with His stripes we are healed. (6) All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the LORD hath laid on Him the iniquity of us all. (8) ... He was cut off out of the land of the living: for the transgression of my people was He stricken.



(5) ... thy name shall be Abraham: (7) And I will establish My covenant between Me and thee and thy seed after thee ... for an everlasting covenant, to be a God unto thee ... Exo 3 (6) ... I am the God of thy father, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac. and the God of Jacob. (14) And God said unto Moses, I AM THAT I AM:



thou failen from heaven,

O Lucifer, son of the morning!
how art thou cut down to the ground,
which didst weaken the nations! (13)
For thou hast said in thine heart,
I will ascend into heaven,
I will exalt my throne above
the stars of God: ... (14) ...
I will be like the most High.
(15) Yet thou shalt be brought

Satan ~ Death ~ Hell

Revelation 20 (1) And I saw an angel come down from heaven, having the key of the bottomless pit and a great chain in his hand. (2) And he laid hold on the dragon, that old serpent, which is the **Devil.** and **Satan**, and bound him a thousand years. (3) And cast him into the bottomless pit, and shut him up, and set a seal upon him, that he should deceive the nations no more, till the thousand years should be fulfilled; and after that he must be loosed a little season. (7) And when the thousand years are expired, **Satan** shall be loosed out of his prison, (8) And shall go out to deceive the nations which are in the four quarters of the earth, ... (10) And the devil that deceived them was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone, ... and shall be tormented day and night for ever and ever. (14) And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death.



Ignorance or Rebellion?

Psalm 1 (1) Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful. (2) But his delight is in the law of the LORD; and in His law doth he meditate day and night. (3) And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper.

(4) The ungodly are not so: but are like the chaff which the wind driveth away. (5) Therefore the ungodly shall not stand in the judgment, nor sinners in the congregation of the righteous. (6) For the LORD knoweth the way of the righteous: but the way of the ungodly shall perish.

Nehemiah 9 (16) But they ... hearkened not to Thy commandments. (17) And refused to obey, neither were mindful of Thy wonders that Thou didst among them; but hardened their necks, and in their rebellion ... return to their bondage: but Thou art a God ready to pardon, gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and of great kindness ...

Seed & Sower: rocky ground ~ Refuse

Luke 8 (11) ... The seed is the word of God. (12) Those by the way side are they that hear; then cometh the devil, and taketh away the word out of their hearts, lest they should believe and be saved.

Romans 1 (28) ... they did not like to retain God in their knowledge, God gave them over to a reprobate mind, to do those things which are not convenient; (29) Being filled with all unrighteousness, fornication, wickedness, covetousness, maliciousness; full of envy, murder, debate, deceit, malignity; whisperers, (3) Backbiters, haters of God, despiteful, proud, boasters, inventors of evil things, disobedient to parents, (31) Without understanding, covenant-breakers, without natural affection, implacable, unmerciful: (32) Who knowing the judgment of God, that they which commit such things are worthy of death, not only do the same, but have pleasure

in them that do them. so, what's YOUR excuse?

Matthew 10 (28) And fear not them which kill the body, but are not able to kill the soul: but rather fear Him which is able to destroy both soul and body in hell. (32) Whosoever therefore shall confess Me before men, him will I confess also before My Father which is in heaven. (33) But whosoever shall deny Me before men, him will I also deny before My Father which is in heaven.

Luke 8 (4) ... He [Jesus] spake by a parable: (5) A sower went out to sow his seed; and as he sowed, some fell by the way side; ... (6) And some fell upon a rock: ... (7) And some fell among thorns; ... (13) They on the rock are they, which, when they hear, receive the word with joy; and these have no root, which for a while believe. and in time of temptation fall away. (14) And that which fell among thorns are they, which, when they have heard, go forth, and are choked with cares and riches and pleasures of this life, and bring no fruit to perfection.

Why choose to die?

Genesis 6 (3) And the LORD said, My spirit shall not always strive with man, ... (5) And GOD saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually. (6) And it repented the LORD that He had made man on the earth, and it grieved Him at His heart.

(8) But Noah found grace in the eyes of the LORD. (13) And God said unto Noah, The end of all flesh is come before Me; for the earth is filled with violence through them; ... (17) And, behold, I, even I, do bring a flood of waters upon the earth, to destroy all flesh, wherein is the breath of life, ... (18) But with thee will I establish My covenant; and thou shalt come into the ark, thou, and thy sons, and thy wife, and thy sons' wives with thee. (19) ... to keep them alive with thee; ...

Ezekiel 33 (11) ... As I live, saith the Lord GOD, I have no pleasure in the death of the wicked; but that the wicked turn from his way and live: turn ye, turn ye from your evil ways; for why will ye die, ...

Seed & Sower: rocky ground ~ Reject

LAW reveals SIN

1 John 3 (4) Whosoever committeth sin transgresseth also the law: for sin is the transgression of the law. (5) And ye know that He [Jesus] was manifested to take away our sins; and in Him is no sin. (6) Whosoever abideth in Him sinneth not: whosoever sinneth hath not seen Him. neither known Him. (8) He that committeth sin is of the devil: for the devil sinneth from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God [Jesus] was manifested, that He might destroy the works of the devil.

2 Peter 3 (3) ... there shall come in the last days scoffers, walking after their own lusts, (4) And saying, Where is the promise of His coming? for since the fathers fell asleep, all things continue as they were from the beginning of the creation. (5) For this they willingly are ignorant of, that by the word of God the heavens were of old, and the earth standing out of the water and in the water: (6) Whereby the world that then was, being overflowed with water, perished: (7) But the heavens and the earth, which are now, by the same word are kept in store, reserved unto fire against the day of judgment and perdition of ungodly men. (9) The Lord ... is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.
