

I AM THE LORD: I will bring you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians (the world)

JOHN 1

(29) ... John [the Baptist] seeth Jesus coming unto him, and saith, Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world. (34) And I saw, and bare record that this is the Son of God. (35) ... Jesus took bread, ... Take, eat; this is my body. (27) And He took the cup, ... (28) For this is my blood of the new testament, which is shed for many for the remission of sins.

God's Heart

RESTITUTION: restore a loss or injury to the previous state & rightful owner by legal action

HEBREWS 9 (see Acts 3:18-21)

(22) And almost all things are by the law purged with blood; and without shedding of blood is no remission [of sin]. (24) For Christ is not entered into the holy places made with hands, ... but into heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of God for us; (26) ... now once ... hath He appeared to put away sin by the sacrifice of Himself. (28) So Christ was once offered to bear the sins of many;

Man's Heart

I AM THE LORD: I will rid you out from their bondage (of the Egyptians = of the world)

JOHN 3

(5) Jesus answered, ... (16) For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life. (17) For God sent not His Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through Him might be saved. (18) He that believeth on Him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already ...

God's Heart

REGENERATION: renew or recuperate after injury; process to reform, reestablish well-being

ROMANS 3

(22) ... the righteousness of God, which is by faith of Jesus Christ unto all and upon all them that believe: ... (23) For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God; (24) Being justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus: (25) Whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation through faith in His blood, to declare His righteousness for the remission of sin

Man's Heart

I AM THE LORD: I will redeem you, with a stretched out arm, and with great judgments: ...

JOHN 1

(1) In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. (3) All things were made by Him; and without Him was not any thing made that was made. (4) In Him was life; and the life was the light of men, (12) But as many as received Him, to them gave He power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on His Name: (13) Which were born ... of God.

God's Heart

REDEMPTION: regain, rescue, or release by paying a price or providing a ransom to restore

COLOSSIANS 1

(12) Hath made us meet to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in light: (13) Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the redemption of His dear Son: (14) In whom we have redemption through His blood, even the forgiveness of sins: (15) Who is the image of the invisible God, ... (16) For by Him were all things created ...

Man's Heart

I AM THE LORD: I will take you to me for a people (separate & sanctify unto Almighty God)

JOHN 17

(1) These words spake Jesus, ... Father, the hour is come; glorify Thy Son, that Thy Son also may glorify Thee: (3) And this is life eternal, that they might know Thee the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom Thou hast sent. (17) Sanctify them through Thy word Thy Word is truth. (23) ... as thou, Father, art in me, and I in thee, that they also may be one in us: ... (23) that the world may know that Thou ... hast loved them.

God's Heart

RECONCILIATION: resolve conflicts, settle differences, bring all to harmonious agreement

COLOSSIANS 1

(19) For it pleased the Father that in Him [Jesus] should all fullness dwell; (20) And, having made peace through the blood of His cross, by Him to reconcile all things unto Himself; ... (21) And you, that were sometime alienated and enemies in your mind by wicked works, yet now hath He reconciled (22) In the body of His flesh through death, to present you holy and unblamable and unreprieveable in His sight:

Man's Heart

I AM THE LORD: I will be to you a God: & ye shall know that I am the LORD your God ...

JOHN 14

(1) Let not your heart be troubled: ... (2) I go to prepare a place for you. (3) ... I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also. (6) Jesus saith ... I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father but by me. (23) ... If a man love me, he will keep my words: and my Father will love him, and we will come unto him, and make our abode with him.

God's Heart

RESTORATION: return to former position ~ unimpaired & uncorrupted condition or relation

EPHESIANS 1

(3) Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who hath blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Christ: (5) having predestinated us unto the adoption of children by Jesus Christ to Himself, according to the good pleasure of His will, (7) In whom we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace;
