THE NAME

John 14 (6) Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by Me. (9) ... he that hath seen Me hath seen the Father. Matthew 28 (18) And Jesus came ... saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth. (19) Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost: (20) Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world.



THE SIGN: THE CROSS

Philippians 2 (5) ... Christ Jesus: (6) Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God: (8) And being found in fashion as a man, He humbled Himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross. (9) Wherefore, God also hath highly exalted Him, and given Him a Name which is above every name: (10) That at the Name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth; (11) And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is LORD, to the glory of God the Father.



THE GLORY

Luke 2 (4) And Joseph also went up from Galilee, ... (5) ... with Mary his espoused wife, being great with child. (8) And there were in the same country shepherds abiding in the field, keeping watch over their flock by night. (9) And, lo, the angel of the Lord came upon them, and the glory of the Lord shone round about them: and they were sore afraid. (10) And the angel said unto them, Fear not: for, behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy, which shall be to all people. (11) For unto you is born this day in the city of David a **Saviour, which is Christ the Lord**.



THE SIGN: THE MANGER

Luke 2 (12) And this shall be a sign unto you; Ye shall find the babe wrapped in swaddling clothes, lying in a manger. (13) And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God, and saying, Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, good will toward men. (13) And it came to pass, as the angels were gone away from them into heaven, the shepherds said ... Let us now go even unto Bethlehem, and see this thing which is come to pass, which the Lord hath made know unto us.



THE WORD

John 1 (1) In the beginning was the Word, and the **Word was with God**, and the **Word was God**. (2) The same was in the beginning with God. (3) All things were made by Him; and without Him was not any thing made that was made. (4) In Him was life; and the life was the light of men. (14) And the **Word was made flesh**, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth. (18) No man hath seen God at any time; the only begotten Son ... hath declared Him

THE SIGN: THE MESSIAH

John 3 (16) For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life. Colossians 1 (12) Giving thanks unto the Father ... (13) Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the kingdom of His dear Son: (14) In Whom we have redemption through His blood, even the forgiveness of sins: (15) Who is the image of the invisible God ... (16) For by Him were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, ...



THE POWER

Romans 1 (1) ... the gospel of God, (3) Concerning his Son Jesus Christ our Lord, which was made of the seed of David according to the flesh; (4) And declared to be the Son of God with power, according to the spirit of holiness, by the resurrection from the dead: (16) ... for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; John 1 (12) But as many as received Him, to them gave He power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on His Name. John 3 (17) For God sent not His Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through Him might be saved.

THE SIGN: THE RESURRECTION

Acts 4 (10) Be it known unto you, ... that by the Name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom ye crucified, whom God raised from the dead, ... (12) Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other Name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved. 1Corinthians 15 (3) .. Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures; (4) And that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day according to the scriptures: (20) But now is Christ risen from the dead, and become the firstfruits of them that slept.



THE KINGDOM

Mark 1 (14) ... Jesus came into Galilee, preaching the gospel of the kingdom of God, (15) And saying, The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand: repent ye, & believe the gospel. Mark 12 (28) Which is the first commandment of all? (29) And Jesus answered ... Hear, O Israel; The Lord our God is one Lord: (3) And thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, & with all thy soul, & with all thy mind, & with all thy strength: John 10 (30) I & my Father are one. (38) The Father is in Me, & I in Him.



THE SIGN: THE CROWN

John 18 (33) Then Pilate ... called Jesus, and said unto Him, Art thou the King of the Jews? (34) Jesus answered, My kingdom is not of this world: ... (37) ... To this end was I born, and for this cause came I into the world ... 1John 5 (5) ... he that believeth that Jesus is the Son of God? (6) This is He that came by water and blood, even Jesus Christ; ... (7) For there are three that bear record in heaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost: and these three are one. (8) And there are three that bear witness in earth, the Spirit, and the water, and the blood
