

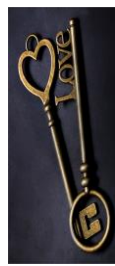
**JOHN 3** (16) For God so loved the world, that He gave His only Begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life. (17) For God sent not His Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through Him might be saved. (18) He that believeth in Him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already ...

**LOVE:** to be deeply committed and connected to someone and giving selflessly for another's good



**JOHN 13** (1) Now before the feast of the Passover, when Jesus knew that His hour was come that He should depart out of this world unto the Father, having loved His own which were in the world, He loved them unto the end. 1 John 4 (10) Herein is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us, and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins. Rev1 (5)... from Jesus Christ, ... Unto Him that loved us, and washed us from our sins in His own blood.

**LOVE:** John 10 (3) I and My Father are one. John 15 (9) As the Father hath loved Me, so have I loved you: continue ye in my love.



**GRACE & MERCY:** GOD's gift to us not deserved, while not receiving what is deserved

**GENESIS 19** (19) Behold now, thy servant hath found grace in Thy sight, and Thou hast magnified Thy mercy, which thou has shewed unto me in saving my life; Exodus 20 (5) ... I the LORD thy God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children ... of them that hate Me; and shewing mercy unto thousands of them that love Me, and keep my commandments.



**MERCY:** Matt 5 (7) Blessed are the merciful: for they shall obtain mercy. Luke 6 (36) Be ye therefore merciful,

**HEBREWS 2** (9) But we see Jesus, (17) Wherefore in all things it behoved Him to be made like unto His brethren, that He might be a merciful and faithful high priest in things pertaining to God, to make reconciliation for the sins of the people. Hebrews 8 (12) For I will be merciful to their unrighteousness, and their sins and their iniquities will I remember no more. Luke 18 (13) And the publican ... smote upon his breast, saying, God be merciful to me a sinner.



**COMPASSION:** someone else's heartbreak becomes another's suffering and partaken with **2 KINGS 13** (23) And the LORD was gracious unto them, and had compassion on them, and had respect unto them, because of His covenant with Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, and would not destroy them, neither cast He them from His presence ... 1 Kings 8 (22) ... LORD God of Israel, there is no God like Thee, ... (50) and forgive Thy people that have sinned against Thee, and all their transgressions wherein they have transgressed against Thee, and give them compassion ...



**COMPASSION:** Mark 1 (41) And Jesus, moved with compassion, put forth His hand, and touched him ...

**MATTHEW 9** (35) And Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every sickness and every disease among the people. (36) But when He saw the multitudes, He was moved with compassion on them, because they fainted, and were scattered abroad, as sheep having no shepherd. (37) Then saith He unto His disciples, The harvest truly is plenteous ... (38) pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest, that He will send forth labourers ...



**SORROW:** anguish, grieving, mourning, heartbreak over loss, suffering, contrary results of one's intention

**GENESIS 2** (16) And the LORD God commanded the man, saying, Of every tree of the garden thou mayest freely eat: (17) But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, thou shalt not eat of it: for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die. Gen 6 (5) And GOD saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually. (6) And it repented the LORD that He had made man on the earth, and it grieved Him at His heart.



**SORROW:** Matt 26 (38) Then saith He unto them, My Soul is exceeding sorrowful, even unto death: ...

**LUKE 22** (41) And He [Jesus] ... kneeled down, and prayed, (42) Saying, Father, if Thou be willing, remove this cup from Me: nevertheless not My will, but Thine, be done. (44) And being in an agony He prayed more earnestly: and His sweat was as it were great drops of blood falling down to the ground. 2Corinth 5 (20) ... we pray you in Christ's stead, be ye reconciled to God. (21) For He hath made Him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in Him.



**WRATH:** feeling of extreme anger, activating judgment, a deserved punishment or retribution

**NAHUM 1** (2) God is jealous, and the LORD revengeth; the LORD revengeth, and is furious; the LORD will take vengeance on His adversaries, and He reserveth wrath for His enemies. Zech 8 (14) For thus saith the LORD of hosts; As I thought to punish you, when your fathers provoked Me to wrath ... Isaiah 54 (8) In a little wrath I hid My face from thee for a moment; but with everlasting kindness will I have mercy on thee, saith the LORD thy Redeemer.



**WRATH:** Romans1 (18) For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness

**ROMANS 5** (8) But God commendeth His love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. (9) Much more then, being now justified by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath through Him. (10) For if, when we were enemies, we were reconciled to God by the death of His Son, much more, being reconciled, we shall be saved by His life. 1Thes 5 (9) For God hath not appointed us to wrath, but to obtain salvation by our Lord Jesus
